Mayor Gilbreath called the special meeting of the City Council to order and provided an opportunity for the public to address them on the subjects which were scheduled on the agenda.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Police Department – Several people spoke in support of the Redlands Police Department and recommended against cutting the budget. Citizens disagreed with the severity of the proposed cuts and the specific positions and services which were to be cut from the Police force.

Recreation Centers – Support was expressed for the recreation centers in Redlands. Reacting to a proposal that the centers would be limited to operating hours of Monday through Thursday, from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. due to the budget cuts, some pointed out the importance of after school programs which run into the evening and keep “at risk” children off the streets and involved in constructive activities.

NEW BUSINESS

Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Budget – Continuing with the presentation structure begun at the June 2, 2010 Special City Council meeting, each staff department provided a summary of impacts to expect as a consequence of expenditure cuts at the 12% and 17% levels. Details included the personnel positions proposed for deletion.
