The plan’s concept is to have a comprehensive Emergency Management Document (base plan) that the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Responder can have and use at the time of an EOC activation. It also has five other areas that will cover prevention, preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation. This plan will be reviewed and taken to the council for adoption.
