



## ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM COMMITMENT

The Adopt-A-Street program has been established for community and civic organizations, as well as private businesses and industry to contribute towards the effort of maintaining cleaner and more beautiful streets in Redlands. The purpose of Redlands' Adopt-A-Street program is to encourage community residents and organizations to adopt local blocks of streets and keep them litter-free. The adopted areas are to be cleaned every 3 months in an effort to maintain a healthy environment, and to produce feelings of pride in our beautiful city.

The Entity understands that the work to be performed can result in physical injury or damage to property and agrees to assume the risk. The Entity hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the City of Redlands, and any neighborhood committee, their officers, employees and agents respectively from liability for any and all claims, damages or injuries of any kind or nature which the Entity, its employees, members or agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program.

The Entity agrees that signs bearing the business/organization or individuals name will be installed solely at the discretion of Redlands Adopt-A-Street Program.

Redlands Adopt-A-Street recognizes the Entity:

The Entity volunteers are to pick up litter at least every 3 months (or more if necessary) along its section of street for a period beginning \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, and ending \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_. **Contract commitment is for a minimum of 1 to 2 years.**

Items provided for clean-up are: Clean-Up Reports (to be turned in after each clean-up), work gloves, trash bags and safety vests. If safety vests are misplaced, the City is not responsible for replacement; however vests are required to perform Adopt-A-Street duties.

**Note:** Items collected by Redlands Adopt-A-Street participants should be litter and debris that can fit into the trash bags provided. Tires, brush and other bulky items should be stacked nearby, not on top of, or under trash bags. Bags of collected trash should not exceed 20-25 pounds. Filled bags should be clustered in convenient locations for solid waste collection. Bags should not be placed in the road or sidewalk. The Entity contact person should call or email the Facilities and Community Services Adopt-A-Street Coordinator the next working day to report where bags of trash have been left.
