I. CALL TO ORDER AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD - 3 MINUTES

It was moved by Commissioner Peyton, seconded by Vice Chairman McNaughton and carried on a 7-0 vote that the Historic and Scenic Preservation Commission recommend that the City Council designate the residence at 1621 Garden Street as a Historic Resource pursuant to Section 2.62 of the Redlands Municipal Code based on the findings.

It was moved by Commissioner Peyton, seconded by Vice Chairman McNaughton and carried on 7-0 that the Historic and scenic Preservation Commission recommend to the City council that the residence at 1621 Garden street be official known as the "Robert J. Dunn Home".
