A. Minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 26, 2018

Following the meeting being called to order and roll call, a motion was made by Commissioner Jaiswal and seconded by Commissioner Roman to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of July 26, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Communications

A. Work Order Status Update (Michael Pool, MUED)

Staff provided a status of items previously presented to the Commission and approved by City Council along with an update on new and pending traffic and/or parking related work orders.

B. Live Oak Canyon Proposed No Passing Zone Signs (Michael Pool, MUED)

Staff discussed status of proposed No Passing Zone signs along Live Oak Canyon Road between San Timoteo Canyon Road and Outer Highway 10.

5. New Business

A. Recommend to City Council establish No Parking Zone on Iowa Street (Joey Long, MUED)

Staff presented their recommendation to recommend to City Council establishment of a no parking zone on Iowa street adjacent to 600 Iowa Street.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jaiswal and seconded by Commissioner Devoe to recommend to City Council Establishment of a No Parking Zone on Iowa Street. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Recommend to City Council establish a 15-minute Time Limit Parking Zone on Parkwood Drive. (Joey Long, MUED)

Staff presented their recommendation to recommend to City Council establishment of a 15-minute time limit parking zone on Parkwood Drive. Resident Sheila Field spoke in favor of the 15-minute time limit parking zone. Sergeant Ohlson cautioned on RPD availability to enforce timed parking and expected response times. Commissioners voiced concern over the restrictive time limit and effectiveness of the proposed zone.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jaiswal and seconded by Commissioner Roman to recommend to City Council Establishment of a 2-hour Time Limit Parking Zone on Parkwood Drive. The motion was tied at a 2-2 vote.

A motion was made by Chairperson Estrada and seconded by Commissioner Devoe to Table the Establishment of a Time Limit parking Zone on Parkwood Drive to the next Traffic and Parking Commission Meeting to explore additional options. The motion carried unanimously.
