The Redlands Chamber of Commerce hosted the eighth annual State of the Community luncheon. Chamber of Commerce President Paul Barich welcomed those present. Chamber of Commerce President-elect Paul Foster led the audience with the pledge of allegiance and delivered an invocation. Mr. Barich introduced Mayor Harrison who called the special City Council meeting to order and asked if there were any public comments regarding subjects scheduled on this agenda. None were forthcoming.

Mayor Harrison and Councilmembers Gil, Gallagher and Aguilar spoke for approximately ten minutes each.
