NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, will hold public hearing on the following:

**PUBLIC HEARING** for consideration of an **Appeal** of a decision by the Minor Exception Permit Committee to approve Minor Exception Permit No. 589. Minor Exception Permit No. 589 approved the installation of a five-foot (5'0") high vinyl fence within the twenty-five foot (25'0") front yard area and the street-side yard area, where a maximum fence height of three feet (3'0") is otherwise permitted by Redlands Municipal Code Section 18.168.020(B). The subject property is located at 303 South Michigan Street in the Multiple Family Residential (R-2) District. The proposed project is exempt from environmental review in accordance with Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) including construction of fences.
