

# CITY OF REDLANDS CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, will hold public hearing to consider the following:

1. Consideration of a Notice of Exemption determination pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), in that the proposal will not result in any potentially significant environmental effects, and will not result in any direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical changes in the environment.
2. **PUBLIC HEARING** to consider **Ordinance No. 2881 (Ordinance Text Amendment No. 355)** for a proposal to amend Article X of Chapter 18.156 of the Redlands Municipal Code, entitled "Private Residential Sports and Recreation Courts," to deem as approved ("grandfathered" from existing regulations) private residential recreation courts in their existing configuration and placement as of March 23, 2018, and make other minor changes to the regulations governing private residential recreation courts.

On March 26, 2019, the Planning Commission reviewed the above-referenced proposal and voted 4 to 3 recommending approval to the City Council. If you challenge the ordinance described in this notice in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at or prior to the public hearing.

Due to time constraints and the number of persons wishing to give oral testimony, time restrictions may be placed on oral testimony at any hearing about this project. You may wish to make your comments in writing to assure that you are able to express yourself adequately.
