1. Presentation by Redlands Community Hospital

RN Krystal Hedjazi, a full-time disaster coordinator at Redlands Community Hospital provided a PowerPoint presentation to explain how the hospital is prepared for a disaster. She spoke about the training staff at Redlands Community employees are provided. Redlands Community partners with: Inland Counties Emergency Medical Agency (ICEMA), Public Health, and City of Redlands. They also offer training: Hospital Incident Command System (HICS), Hazmat, Incident Action Planning, drills, High Risk Protective Equipment, and Centers for Domestic Preparedness. If all other communication fails, they are ready with: Reddinet, California Health Alert Network, and HAM radios.

2. OmniTrans

Mark Crosby, Security and Loss Prevention Supervisor at OmniTrans spoke of how they are prepared in case of a disaster. Their buses run from San Bernardino Valley, Yucaipa to Pomona, they cover approximately 456 miles and serve 1.5 million people annually. They are a joint powers authority and employ 640 people. All employees are trained Disaster Service Workers, they have their own Mobil Command Center and Emergency Operations Center (EOC). They help respond to small emergencies such as evacuation of hospitals.

3. Fay reminded everyone of The ShakeOut Workshop on August 14th from 5:30pm to 9pm, CERT class for August 21-23, CESA Conference for September 28th to October 1st, The ShakeOut Drill on October 15th, CERT Affiliate Training on November 7th 8am-2pm, and finally the Resource Guide is now available for everyone to view.
