The last she spoke about was the Community Emergency Response Team Training that the division held. Out of the 626 participants, 300 of them have been City of Redlands residents.
 - b. Carrie Cruz, Emergency Services Coordinator gave an update on the status of San Bernardino County Office of Emergency Services. The county department had several job vacancies. Gave updates on the status of the Winter 2023 Blizzards and status of the county. She mentioned that before the blizzards, they were also dealing with a water main break in the communities of the high dessert. She mentioned that FEMA was at the county helping residents that were impacted by the winter storms.
