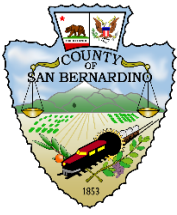

## San Bernardino County Telephone Emergency Notification System (TENS)

In an effort to quickly communicate information on impending dangers, the San Bernardino County Sheriff and Fire Departments send high-speed mass notifications via telephone and text messages. This system is known as the Telephone Emergency Notification System (TENS).

The County uses a database of landline telephone numbers, which is updated every six months, to send emergency messages to landline phones only. By signing up, residents can also receive emergency text messages on their cell phones, add voice over internet phone numbers (V.O.I.P.), and manage their own account using a valid email address. Those without internet connections can sign up by calling 211 or (909) 980-2857 for assistance in registering.

TENS alerts do not generally go out to the entire County but instead are targeted to affected areas. You must enter a valid San Bernardino County address. This is the address for which you will receive alerts.

*The County of San Bernardino utilizes multiple ways to notify residents of impending danger, but residents should not wait for or rely exclusively on any single notification system. If you are concerned about your safety and welfare, please evacuate.*



## San Bernardino County Telephone Emergency Notification System (TENS)

En un esfuerzo por comunicar rápidamente información sobre peligros inminentes, el Sheriff y el Departamento de Bomberos del Condado de San Bernardino envían notificaciones masivas de alta velocidad a través de mensajes telefónicos y de texto. Este sistema se conoce como Sistema de Notificación Telefónica de Emergencia (TENS).

El Condado utiliza una base de datos de números de teléfono fijos, que se actualiza cada seis meses, para enviar mensajes de emergencia únicamente a los teléfonos fijos. Al inscribirse, los residentes también pueden recibir mensajes de texto de emergencia en sus teléfonos móviles, añadir números de teléfono de voz por Internet (V.O.I.P.) y manejar su propia cuenta utilizando una dirección de correo electrónico válida. Quienes no tengan conexión a Internet pueden inscribirse llamando al 211 o al (909) 980-2857 para que les ayuden a registrarse.

Las alertas de TENS no suelen llegar a todo el condado, sino que se dirigen a las zonas afectadas. Debe introducir una dirección válida del Condado de San Bernardino. Esta es la dirección para la que recibirá las alertas.
