REQUEST FOR OVERSIGHT BOARD ACTION

SUBJECT: CONSIDERATION OF PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT AND ESCROW INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SALE OF 330 NORTH THIRD STREET (ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NOS. 0169-281-47, 48, 49 AND 50) BETWEEN THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY OF THE FORMER CITY OF REDLANDS REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND ARTECO PARTNERS INC., AND A DETERMINATION THAT THE SALE IS EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Oversight Board approve the Purchase and Sale Agreement.

BACKGROUND:

The Property is located at 330 North Third Street; south of Shopper's Lane, West of Third Street, and is comprised of four parcels totaling approximately 29,159 square feet in size. The Property is generally flat and has been improved with a masonry and steel framed warehouse building approximately 18,792 square foot in size and constructed circa 1906 as a citrus packing house. The building's foundation walls appear to be rock set in mortar. The main floor of the building is elevated approximately four to five feet above grade. The original building contained loading docks along its west and south elevations, which have been enclosed (stucco over wooden walls) when the use changed to industrial purposes. The building contains a basement that is approximately 14,000 square feet in size; is approximately four to five feet below grade; is unfinished; and has a clearance of less than the City's Municipal Code requirement of 8 feet.

The Property is located within the Santa Fe Depot District, which has been listed in the Historic District on the National Register of Historic Places. The site is vacant and has been unused for several years.

At the November 17, 2015, meeting the Board moved to proceed with a performancebased sales approach to dispose of the subject property designated for sale in the Successor Agency's Long-Range Property Management Plan (LRPMP). In a related motion, the Board also appointed the Board Chairman (Foster) and Vice Chairman (Harrison) to a Property Disposition Subcommittee (Subcommittee) to work with staff to develop the selection/performance criteria that would be used to determine a viable

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City of Redlands will receive Three Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$320,000.00) for the sale of the subject property. Development related fees, retail sales tax and property tax earnings will also be received.

RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD FOR THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND SALE AGREEMENT AND ESCROW INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE SALE OF 330 NORTH THIRD STREET (ASSESSOR'S PARCEL NOS. 0169-281-47, 48, 49 AND 50) BETWEEN THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY OF THE FORMER CITY OF REDLANDS REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND ARTECO PARTNERS INC., AND A DETERMINATION THAT THE SALE IS EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34173(d), the City of Redlands ("Successor Agency") is the successor agency to the former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Redlands ("Agency"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34173(g), the Successor Agency is now a separate legal entity from the City, and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34191.5(b) requires the Successor Agency to prepare a Long-Range Property Management Plan ("LRPMP") that addresses the disposition and use of the real properties of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency has prepared a LRPMP which was subsequently approved by the Department of Finance on September 8, 2015; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34191.3, the approved LRPMP shall govern, and supersede all other provisions relating to, the disposition and use of all the real properties of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code section 34179(a) provides that each successor agency shall have an oversight board composed of seven members; and

WHEREAS, the Oversight Board is the Successor Agency's oversight board pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34179(a); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety code section 34177(e), the Successor Agency is responsible for disposing the properties of the former Agency, as directed by the Oversight Board, expeditiously and in a manner aimed at maximizing value; provided, however, that the Oversight Board may instead direct the Successor Agency to transfer ownership of assets that were constructed and used for government purpose or future development, to the appropriate public jurisdiction pursuant to any existing agreements relating to construction or use of such assets pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34181(a); and
