The City of Redlands collects household hazardous waste each Saturday from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at 500 Kansas Street, Redlands.

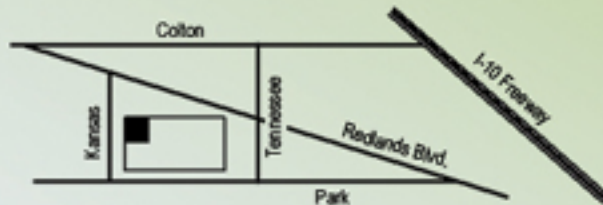
DISPOSE OF THESE EXCESS HOUSEHOLD MATERIALS:

Paint Products	Automotive Oil & Filters
Chemical Cleaners	Brake / Transmission Fluid
Pesticides	Anti-Freeze
Fertilizers	Gasoline
Hobby / Pool Supplies	Propane Tanks

WASTES NOT ACCEPTED:

Business Wastes	Radioactive Wastes
Medical Wastes	Explosives
Reactives	Asbestos
Electronic Wastes (Call 1-800-OILY-CAT for disposal options)	

Please be careful transporting chemicals to disposal site! Loads are limited to 15 gallons or 125 pounds maximum per visit in containers no larger than 5 gal.
