



Homeless Shower Program at Redlands Family YMCA

Description:

The Shower Program at the Redlands YMCA is currently an ongoing volunteer outreach program designed to minimize disease spread (both COVID 19 and Hep A) by providing segments of the homeless population with the availability of showers on a limited basis.

Details:

- Available Mondays and Wednesdays, 1:00pm to 2:30pm.
- Must signup at First United Methodist Church Food Station on the day of between 11:00 and 1:00pm.
- Shower guests are given a time slot and a shower ticket which they must present at the Shower Registration Table at the YMCA.
- No walk-ins and no late arrivals permitted.
- Showers are cleaned and sprayed with a anti-coronavirus solution after each use.
- Fresh towels, socks and hygiene kits are provided to each guest.
- Volunteers are masked and gloved and instructed in safety protocols.

This program will continue until the State of California Emergency Declaration is lifted.
