Please be advised that the San Bernardino County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment for the California Street Landfill (SWIS# 36-AA-0017). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the San Bernardino County, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

The California Street Landfill is located at 2151 Nevada Street, Redlands, California 92373. On - June 28, 2024, the LEA received an RFI amendment application package to address the "Findings" identified during the facility's 5-Year Permit Review.

The amendment package included the following:

- Revised Application for Solid Waste Facility Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements
- Updated Joint Technical Document with Appendices and Figures
- Updated Non-Water Release Corrective Action Plan
- Updated Preliminary Closure and Post Closure Maintenance Plan
- Updated Cost Estimates and Financial Assurance Documents

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the RFI amendment on August 2, 2024.
