



Make Child-size Face Masks

A project of the Rochford Foundation

Description:

- A volunteer-based program to provide child-size face masks for Redlands youngsters, coordinated by the Rochford Foundation, is now underway and seeking more volunteers. The effort is in response to anticipated continuation of requirements for social distancing and wearing face masks in public during the Covid-19 pandemic.

- The homemade masks will be distributed by the Rochford Foundation to Redlands' Boys & Girls Club, YMCA, Family Service Association, the Blessing Center, Thrive Single Moms and other child-serving Redlands organizations.

- Volunteers from local chapters of nonprofits such as the Assistance League, National Charity League, Zonta and the Gypsy Tollers are already participating. Anyone with access to a sewing machine and scissors is welcome to join the effort.

- Supplies: The Rochford Foundation can provide needed supplies — fabric, elastic, nose wires, child-size patterns — all available for either curbside pickup downtown or no-contact home delivery. Volunteer mask-makers are also welcome to donate their own materials.
