How Do I Participate In This Program?

To participate, honoree must meet the following criteria:

- Currently serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces; or
- A living veteran who was honorably discharged; and
- A current resident of Redlands or an immediate family member of a resident of Redlands (wife/husband, son/daughter, grandchild, son-in-law/daughter-in-law).

To participate in the program, applications must include an official military photo of the honoree, verification of military status, proof of residency and an application fee of \$175.00 (made payable to the Hometown Heroes Foundation). Banners will be hung for two years. Banners will be installed twice per calendar year, depending on date application is recieved:

- By March 31 To be installed by Memorial Day

By August 31 - To be installed	by veterans Day
