### I. Municipal Utilities/Public Works Commission - Call to Order and Roll Call

Chairperson Stockton called the meeting to order. A quorum was established with four Commissioners present, however, before the meeting concluded, Commissioner Stockton excused himself to attend a separate meeting. The Commission took no action on the item presented.

#### **II.** Communications

A. Presentation of Proposed Flood Control Master Plan and Discussion and Possible Action on Proposed Flood Control Master Plan (RBF Consulting)

The Commission was presented with a proposed flood control master plan which the City anticipates taking to Council requesting their consideration for adoption. Mr. Ryan and Mr. McCarthy, RBF Consulting team who have been coordinating with City staff on the development of the plan, provided a technical overview of the plan and the City's infrastructure needs to implement the plan. The master plan would allow staff to prioritize the needed infrastructure required to have in place for protection from a 100-year storm event.

The cost to construct the drainage facility improvements was also provided. Utilizing up-to-date technology and prior studies other agencies had prepared, the consultant integrated pertinent data into the proposed master plan for the City. Additionally, water quality recommendations and green initiatives were considered for implementation into the plan. Due to additional time requested to review the information presented and the lack of a quorum, the Commission requested to continue the item to the Commission's next regular meeting.
