*During this crisis the City of Redlands has created a Never Alone Program to address the isolation problems faced by many elderly people within the community and foster a better connection with others. The program uses city staff and volunteers to routinely call and establish a connection with the senior citizens in the community. Callers check in on the seniors to verify their health and safety, but they also try to become a friend, someone that seniors can look forward to speaking with on a weekly basis. In situations where someone may be in need of help or they fail to answer the phone call, a police officer is dispatched to check on their status.*

*The Never Alone Project relies entirely on volunteer support, and they are always in need of anyone who may be interested in participating in the program.*
