The following information comprises the minutes for a special meeting of the Parks & Recreation Advisory Commission to be held at <u>5:30 p.m.</u> on <u>Thursday</u>, <u>November 3</u>, <u>2021</u>, in the City Council Chambers, 35 Cajon Street, Suite #2.

1. CALL TO ORDER – Attendance

Commissioner Ferrari's absence was excused

2. PUBLIC COMMENTS

One public comment was received from Redlands Baseball for Youth. Ms. Kevari read the letter.

3. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Discussion and possible action regarding a recommendation on reservations for sports fields per City's new allocation policy
 - a. Ms. Kevari gave an overview of the new field reservation forms as well as an overview of the process and the new policy. Director Boatman discussed in-kind services and what the City plans on accomplishing vis a vis field maintenance with the recently passed budget. A representative from the Pateadores soccer club came and gave public comment. Chair Johnson made a motion to endorse the presented sports field allocations. Second by Vice Chair Wells. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. Discussion on AYSO's use of the City's Sports Park
 - a. Director Boatman gave an update on AYSO's agreement. Chair Johnson requested that he be able to have a meeting with the City Manager and the City Attorney to go over the AYSO agreement. Director Boatman said he would set up such a meeting.
- Discussion and possible action regarding the planned pickle ball court upgrades at the City's Community Center
 - a. Ms. Kevari gave an overview of the project. Chair Johnson requested staff perform a breakdown of how much Development Impact Funds and Palmetto Grove proceeds could be used for this project. Motion by Vice Chair Wells to recommend the project to City Council for approval, maximize DIF use, cover the shortfall with Palmetto Grove proceeds. Second by Chair Johnson. Motion passed 4-1, with Commissioner Hebden dissenting.
