During this crisis the City of Redlands has created a Never Alone Program to address the isolation problems faced by many elderly people within the community and foster a better connection with others. The program uses city staff and volunteers to routinely call and establish a connection with the senior citizens in the community. Callers check in on the seniors to verify their health and safety, but they also try to become a friend, someone that seniors can look forward to speaking with on a weekly basis. In situations where someone may be in need of help or they fail to answer the phone call, a police officer is dispatched to check on their status.

The Never Alone Project relies entirely on volunteer support, and they are always in need of anyone who may be interested in participating in the program.
