(If a new selection process is not established, the City Clerk will conduct the elections of the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tempore for the term of two years. If more than one nomination is made, a public roll call vote will be taken. Nominations do not require a second.)

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the City Council adopt Resolution No. 8157, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Redlands reciting the fact of the General Municipal Election held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, declaring the results and such other matters as provided by law.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law cities, the Redlands City Council adopted Resolution No. 8072 on June 2, 2020, calling and ordering to be held in the City of Redlands, California, a General Municipal Election, and requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino authorize the Registrar of Voters to canvass the returns and provide the necessary services pertaining to the election to be held Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of electing two Members of the City Council by-district, a City Clerk at-large, and a City Treasurer at-large for the full term of four years.

Furthermore, on July 7, 2020, the Redlands City Council adopted Resolution No. 8111, ordering the submission of an ordinance proposing imposition of a Transactions and Use Tax (a General Tax) at the rate of One Percent (1.0%) to the qualified voters of the City of Redlands at the General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2020, and requesting the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Bernardino authorize the Registrar of Voters to canvass the returns.

The San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters provided a Statement of Certification of Election results of the 2020 Statewide General Election, showing the total number of votes cast in San Bernardino County and that the totals as shown are full, true and correct.
