

## TRAP RENTAL AGREEMENT

Please read and sign below:

The Redlands Police Department/Animal Control Division has provided you with the usage of a live humane animal trap.

This trap allows you to trap small animals humanely on your property. We want you to be responsible in using the trap and would like to advise you of the following conditions.

- 1.) You may release any domesticated or wild animal that may become accidentally trapped.
- 2.) You must call the proper authorities when an animal has been trapped. The telephone number to the Redlands Animal Control is (909) 798-7644.
- 3.) You may not destroy or relocate an animal that you have trapped.
- 4.) If you have any information on an animal that you have trapped, you must give this information to the proper authorities.
- 5.) Do not leave the trap in the direct sunlight. Attempt to provide shade for the animal.
- 6.) Check the trap frequently.
- 7.) You are held financially responsible for this trap. If the trap is stolen or destroyed while in your possession you must replace the trap immediately.
- 8.) A late fee of one dollar is charged for each day the trap is over due.
- 9.) Do not trap on Saturday night or Sunday night as the Animal Shelter is closed Sunday and Monday.
- 10) We appreciate your responsibility in action accordingly to these guidelines.
